The 12 spacious rooms are a perfect place to lay your head after a day on the water. All guest rooms have well appointed private baths and daily housekeeping service.

The common areas at North Island Lodge include a spacious lounge with wet bar and fireplace, a dining room and a games area. The upstairs balcony, situated above the weigh-in scale is a perfect place to relax as the boats return from fishing with their trophy catches.

DIVERSIONS FOR THE SOUL

Langara Island and its surroundings is a playground for many of nature's wonders. Throughout the season guests can see several species of whales: humpbacks, greys and orcas rearing out of the sea, at times just several feet from the boat. Schools of porpoises routinely buzz the Island, playfully pacing even the fastest outboards.

The Queen Charlotte Islands are a mecca for bird watchers. The entire region is home to many seldom-seen species and is one of the largest nesting grounds for the rare peregrine falcon and bald eagle.

Just across the strait from North Island is the ancient Haida village of Kiusta (Haida for "where the trail comes out"). The long abandoned site still echoes with the history of a people who fished these same waters centuries ago.

A short walk from Kiusta, through majestic Pacific rainforest, leads to Lepas Bay and to one of the most beautiful, natural sand beaches anywhere. Nature and history are all part of your North Island fishing adventure.

CULINARY DELIGHTS FOR ALL

If North Island is known for the fishing, it is equally famous for its food and hospitality. Guests rave about the variety of food, and the mouth-watering magic performed by Chef Walter and his staff. The kitchen staff is justifiably proud of their richly earned reputation for culinary excellence. It is truly food fit for royalty, served in the world's most majestic setting.



THE FLEET & EQUIPMENT

North Island Lodge has recently added several new 18' and 21' Eaglecraft to its fleet of sturdy aluminum boats. Each new boat is powered by a 75 or 115HP, four-stroke Mercury outboard. Equipment includes VHF radios, downriggers, fish finders and compasses. Guests are outfitted with all-weather ocean survival suits, graphite rods and halibut gear.
